## BVAL Football Jamboree Outline

The BVAL Jamborees will be held on Friday, August 17, 2018 as outlined below

**The sites for 2018 will be as follows (F/S starts at 3:30 - Varsity at 6:30):**

- **Del Mar**– Branham, Del Mar, Leigh, Prospect, Santa Teresa, Westmont (2A/2B/2C)
- **Gunderson**– Gunderson, Leland, Lincoln, Pioneer, San Jose, Willow Glen (3A/2B/2C)
- **Independence** – Independence, Piedmont Hills, Oak Grove, Live Oak, Overfelt, Silver Creek (3A/3B)
- **James Lick** – Andrew Hill, Evergreen Valley, James Lick, Mt. Pleasant, Sobrato, Yerba Buena (remaining 6C)

**General Format:**

- All Jamborees are on Friday, August 17<sup>th</sup> 2018 and will begin at **3:30 PM** for the F/S and **6:30 PM**
- Each round will consist of a **20-minute (F/S) or 30-minute (Varsity) running clock**; there will be no time outs
- A coin flip will determine first possession - The winner can choose Offense or Defense first
- The first offensive series will begin on the 40-yard line, going in (There will be two games going on simultaneously, heading opposite directions). An alternating format will be used, as outlined below (unless there is an agreement by BOTH Head Coaches to vary the format)
  - **An Offensive possession ends with any of the following:**
    - A Touchdown (no PATs will be attempted)
    - A Field Goal
    - An interception or lost fumble (quick whistle, no returns by Defense)
    - A turnover on downs
- At the end of an Offensive possession, the Defensive team takes over at the 40-yard line
- Coaches may be on the field, but **all players not involved in the play must be on the sidelines**
  - *Offensive coaches may be in the huddle, then must retreat to at least 10 yds behind the LOS*
  - *Defensive coaches may be in the huddle, then must retreat to the sideline, end zone (if ball is outside the 20) or behind the end line (if ball is inside the 20)*
- There will be a 5-minute transition period between rounds
- The Frosh/Soph will follow the same format and schedule and will play **20-minute rounds**.
- Each site will provide warm up areas for the teams. Some teams may warm up in the stadium and others outside of the stadium. Any teams with 1<sup>st</sup> round byes, should warm up on outside fields.

### **Hosting Guidelines:**

Host schools will be required to provide the following personnel:

- 1 Site Director
- Athletic Trainer for game coverage for both F/S and Varsity Jamborees (not to exceed \$200 per site)
- 2-4 ADULT ticket sellers volunteers needed for up to 6 hours starting at 2:30PM  
**The BVAL gets 100% of the gate revenue to offset League Dues and other League expenses**
- Police coverage if deemed necessary by site (no more than two (2) per site)
- Custodial Coverage – The host school will absorb this cost unless they are the Saturday host with freshman, F/S and varsity games (rate to be determined and invoiced by their specific school district)
- Volunteers for 2 Chain Crews for all Jamborees

The BVAL will provide invoices for the athletic trainer and the police/security and will send them checks directly. The site director will be in charge of getting invoices filled out correctly and remitted to the BVAL by September 1st.

### **In addition to personnel, each site should provide the following:**

- Start up cash-box as you would for a regular home football game
- 2 sets of chains (you may need to arrange with one of the other participants to bring a 2<sup>nd</sup> set of chains and another down marker)
- The field should be fully lined with yard markers and pylons set up, water jugs for the benches (or a place for teams to fill up their containers)
- The scoreboard should be operational for timing purposes. Announcers are not needed, unless you want to plug your snack shack and use the PA to help with transitioning between “quarters”
- ***Food Concession are to be provided by the host school, which gets 100% of profit***

An official “BVAL Football Jamboree Host Site Packet” will be made up with all forms, pay rates, duties and responsibilities of hosting school included and given to the host school athletic director.

The host site-director will be in charge of collecting money, all record keeping and with turning the proceeds and invoices in to the BVAL office by September 1<sup>st</sup>.

The BVAL has secured officials. They will use this opportunity for training their newer referees, etc. This provides a service for our referee association and defers the cost of officials.

The BVAL Board of Managers has approved this Jamboree format.
