This scholarship is \$500 and the committee seeks nominees who:

- Are a graduating Senior
- Hold a minimum gpa of 3.0
- Have completed a minimum of six (6) seasons of sports at the high school level and have earned a minimum of two (2) Varsity letters
- Have demonstrated leadership in school activities and/or on schools teams
- Have documented incidents demonstrating integrity and self-sacrifice for teammates and school athletic programs
- Have completed the application packet, including:
 - Application Form
 - Three (3) Letters of Recommendation One (1) from the Principal, one (1) from a Coach or Athletic Director, and one (1) from a member of the community
 - These letters needs to specify how the student/athletes improved the athletic teams, school and community environment through her participation in sports and community.
 - These letters should include the leadership qualities and elaborate how these leadership skills will not only impact her future but positively impact society as a whole.

It is your responsibility to return your completed application and supporting documents to the CCS Office. They must be <u>received</u> in the CCS Office (333 Piercy Rd, San Jose, CA 95138) no later than <u>Thursday, February 1, 2018</u>. Thank you and best of luck with your application!
